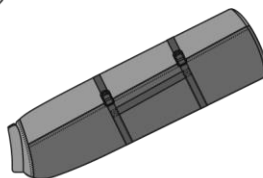

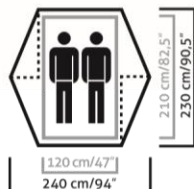

DENALI II

1 - OPEN THE INNER TENT AND ASSEMBLE THE POLES



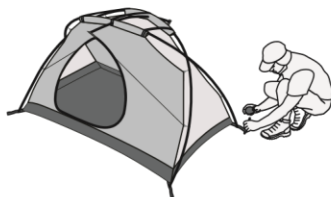
2 - (I) INSERT THE POLES TO THE SLEEVES, (II) FIX THEM TO THE EYELETS, (III) ATTACH THE HOOKS TO THE POLES



3 - INSERT THE TOP POLE INTO THE EYELETS AND FIX IT



4 - FIX THE INNER TENT TO THE GROUND WITH THE PEGS



5 - ADD THE FLYSHEET OVER THE INNER TENT AND FIX IT



6 - STRETCH THE VESTIBULES AND FIX THEM WITH THE PEGS



7 - FIX THE GUY LINES WITH THE PEGS



8 - OPEN THE SIDE VENTILATIONS TO AVOID HUMIDITY
